Until one day, she arrives at the door to learn the unthinkable has happened and nothing will ever be the same for any of them.

Decades later, with her daughter grown and a long career in her wake, Dr. Civil Townsend is ready to retire, to find her peace and to leave the past behind. But there are people and stories that refuse to be forgotten. That must not be forgotten.

Seed Library Launch

Thorntown Public Library is launching its seed library on March 20th. This new project is funded in part by a grant from Boone County Master Gardeners. This will be a free service available to all library guests, no library card required. The seed library will be located on the upper level across from the main circulation desk. Fruit, vegetable, herb, and flower seeds will be available while supplies last.

The program will operate on an honor system. The library asks participants to only take up to 5 packs a week. It will be open from the first day of spring to the first day of summer. Seeds can be requested through the end of September. Unused or harvested seeds at the end of season can be donated for next year's seed library. The library is not responsible for any seeds that do not germinate.
